



Assessment Arrangements

At Swallow Grange Independent School, assessment is an ongoing process that enables us to understand each pupil's strengths, needs and progress over time.

On admission, pupils undertake a baseline assessment to identify their starting points across academic, social, emotional and communication development. Information from Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs), previous settings and specialist reports is also used to inform individual learning programmes.

Progress is monitored through:

- Regular teacher assessment and observation
- Individual learning targets linked to EHCP outcomes where appropriate
- Assessment of academic progress across curriculum areas
- Monitoring of social, emotional and behavioural development
- Termly reviews of pupil progress and attainment
- Annual EHCP reviews for pupils with Education, Health and Care Plans

Assessment information is used to ensure teaching is appropriately adapted to meet each pupil's needs and to support pupils in achieving their individual outcomes.

Parents and carers receive regular updates on their child's progress through review meetings, reports and ongoing communication with school staff.
